Deadline for submission is **Monday, January 11th, 2021 at 11:59 PM PST**. Submit your proposal(s) via the <u>Oxford Abstracts system</u>.

Share your expertise on a wide variety of community development topics. Selected proposals are peer-reviewed by other NACDEP members, ensuring they are of high quality.

Format Options

- 30-minute presentation (including Q & A)
- 90-minute learning workshop
- 15-minute REAL Talks presentation (Relevant, Exploratory, Accessible, Lively) followed by 75-minute moderated discussion
- 3-minute Innovative Program Forum What's your Pitch (pitch a new program with attendee review and feedback)
- 3-hour pre-conference workshop
- 3-hour post conference workshop
- Poster

REAL Talks

REAL Talks (Relevant topics, Exploratory in nature, Accessible to all, Lively conversation) are 15-minute presentations followed by 75 minutes of moderated discussion.

Innovative Program Forum - What's Your Pitch?

Ever wondered if your program idea has already been offered in the Extension system? Want to pitch your idea to a group of esteemed Extension professionals and get feedback? Well, here's your opportunity to do just that! In this session, presenters will have up to 3 minutes to make a pitch and will receive feedback and recommendations from a panel of judges and session attendees.

Submit a Proposal Using Oxford Abstracts

If you have submitted to Oxford Abstracts in the past, you will already have a username and login. If not, you will be asked to create an account in order to access the proposal submission form. Submit your proposal(s) via the Oxford Abstracts system (https://app.oxfordabstracts.com/stages/2248/submitter). Oxford Abstracts does save partial submissions, so you can make changes to your proposal up until the submission deadline of January 11th, 2021. Don't forget to go back in to complete your proposal!

Reviewers needed! Proposals are peer-reviewed by other NACDEP members.

If you are able to serve as a reviewer, you can indicate your availability to review between Jan. 15-29, 2021, while submitting a proposal via the <u>Oxford Abstracts</u> system. If you are not submitting a proposal, but are still willing to review proposals, please contact <u>Rebecca Sero</u> to be added to the reviewer list.
