Connecting Examples: CDE Objectives and Standards/Anchors

Ex. 1 – Related to 1.4.11.B: Write complex informational pieces (e.g., research papers, analyses, evaluations, essays). **During any of the public speaking career development events, the students will be required to construct an informational manuscript related to the agricultural/environmental industry.**

Ex. 2 – Related to 1.5.11.F: Edit writing using the conventions of language. **Throughout the development of the manuscript the student is required to spell all words correctly, use capital letters correctly, use punctuation correctly, use appropriate and grammatically correct word choices and complete sentence structures.**

Ex. 3 – Related to 1.6.11.C: Speak using skills appropriate to formal speech situations. **Students must use a variety of sentence structures to add interest to manuscript and presentation, pace the presentation according to the contest judges and purpose, and adjust stress, volume and inflection to provide emphasis to ideas or to influences the audience.**
